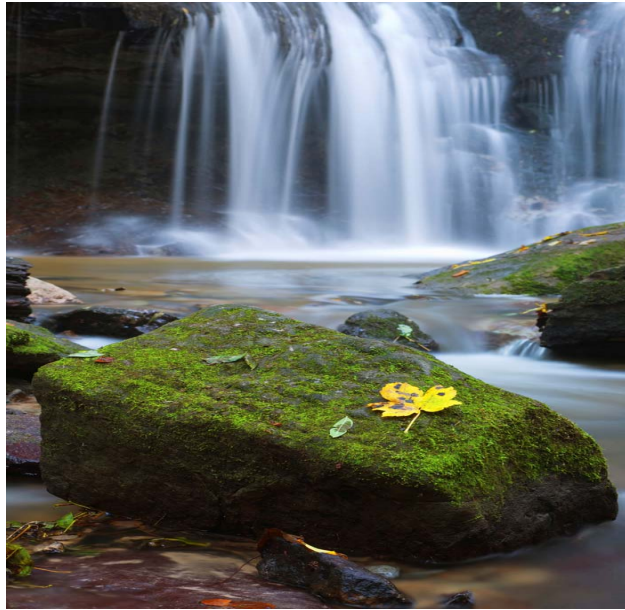


# Faith Community Health Promoter Training Program

## **What is a Faith Community Health Promoter?**

A Faith Community Health Promoter is a layperson serving as a health advocate in a faith community.

Faith Community Health Promoter training formally empowers volunteers for their caring ministry in the church.

It enables leaders to educate and motivate a congregation toward health and wellness, and to improve access to health resources.

## **Goals of Faith Community Health Promoter training:**

- To identify, educate, and equip volunteers in congregational health ministry.
- To improve health and decrease disparities through faith networks.
- To network and collaborate with existing health ministries.

## **Who can be a Faith Community Health Promoter?**

Anyone in a faith community who commits to and completes the training can be a Faith Community Health Promoter. **No medical background necessary!**
